This form should be used by Colorado State University undergraduates to seek approval to apply to the Sequential BA/MA degree program in the Department of Political Science. With the permission of the Graduate Committee of the Political Science Department, the student may be conditionally accepted into the sequential degree program. This does not guarantee admission to the MA program.

The student must still apply for Graduate School admission to the MA program by the time specified for such applications (February 15 for Fall admission - (<https://polisci.colostate.edu/admissions/>)). Admission to the MA portion of the sequential program is contingent on evidence that the student can complete the program on time.

Students are admitted into the MA portion only during the Fall semester. Enrolment into the MA portion is contingent on having completed the BA program and 9 additional and qualified graduate level credits (defined as 500-level regular coursework).

Applications for conditional acceptance into the sequential degree program must be submitted to the Graduate Coordinator of the Department of Political Science by May 31st of the year before the final BA year.
