### Political Science Core Requirements (GPPZ-C 1): (15 credits) All POLS Courses *must be completed with a C grade or better!*

**MUST** take POLS101, 232, & 241

POLS 101: American Politics (3 credits)  
(could double count with 3 credits of AUCC CAT. 3C)

POLS 232: International Relations (3 credits)  
(could double count as 3 credits of AUCC CAT. 1C)

POLS 241: Comparative Politics (3 credits)  
(could double count as 3 credits of AUCC CAT. 1C)

**Also MUST** take POLS160 **OR** 272 (3 credits)

POLS 160: Public Policy & Service **OR** POLS 272: Politics of Power, Justice & Democracy  
(could double count as 3 credits of AUCC CAT. 1C)

**Take Advanced Writing (3 credits: CO 300, CO 301x, CO 302, JTC 300, LB 300)**

NOTE: This may be fulfilled with AUCC Cat 2. POLS major does not allow CO150 to count for this requirement
